

Conditions of Mail auction OLYMSPORT

The auction is organized occasionally by Association OLYMSPORT, mostly from surpluses of their member.

Bidding will be in Czech currency, with advances in the following stages

up to 50 CZK in steps of 2 CZK

up to 100 CZK in steps of 5 CZK

up to 500 CZK in steps of 10 CZK

up to 1000 CZK in steps of 50 CZK

over 1000 CZK in steps of 100 CZ

Bids may be submitted also in EUR and USD. You can select the currency in the top left of this list of items.

up to 2 EUR or USD in steps of 0,10

up to 4 EUR or USD in steps of 0,20

up to 20 EUR or USD in steps of 0,50

up to 40 EUR or USD in steps of 2,00

Over 40 EUR or USD in steps of 4,00

Incorrect bids are moved automatically by the computer to the nearest appropriate multiple.

The item wins the highest bidder, but only one step over the second highest bid. For example: bids 18 - 26 - 50 will be given the bidder who has offered 50 - but for the price of 28 CZK (26 + 2). In the case of identical bids, the lot will be sold to the first bid received (as determined by the postmark or by the time of placing the bids via the Internet or e-mail). If there is only one bidder, he wins at the starting price plus one bid

Unlike commercial auctions, the winner does not pay the organizer's commission.

There are always 100 items in the "List of lots". List has following columns

- [Lot number](#)
- [State](#) – where the lot was issued (see table below)
- [Picture](#) - the thumbnail image increases when it clicks, the image closes with ESC
- [Description of the lot](#) - the three-digit code is given at the end of each item's description, but only for lots really sent by post. The first digit – appearance and quality as a whole, the second digit – quality of cancellations, the third digit – quality of the stamps (if there are)
Rating: 5 – the best quality, 1 - the worst quality. At the stationaries without stamps and machine cancellations there is instead a third number a dash
- [Start price in CZK](#) - starting price, the lowest price that can be submitted in the offer
- [Offer in CZK](#) – there is an edit box in the top left of each list of items where the bidder can choose currency and then bid in this chosen currency.
- [State in CZK](#) – information about current and final price

Note: In order to better inform the bidders of the mail auction, each week before and then two days before the end of auction, second highest bid will be displayed in the box of lot (column "state in CZK")

If there are for item more identical bids, the price is with *. If there is only one bid at that time, there is stated the start price.

How to bid through an internet list:

The bids made through the web are sent after you press the "SEND" button at the bottom of the list automatically by email to the manager of auction. This action is always valid for each list (100 lots). After completing **each** list, be sure to fill in all the required data (name, phone, mail, address) at the end of each list. Completed data can be cleared by using the "Reset" button (note that all is deleted) or corrected before shipping. We recommend reviewing them, we consider the submitted offer to be valid, we confirm it with a return email.

By dividing lots into "rows" we allow bidders to work on a smaller set of lots at the moment, and also react with "offer" right now while viewing lot information. You can still edit the bid amount before submitting a "row" using the "Send" button. Offers will be accepted with filled-in mandatory details and with at least one bid, the bidder will receive back the information about the receipt of the offers from the auction manager of the mail auction. Manager prefers this online bidding process; written offers may inaccurately result in manual transcription of data into automated auction evaluation system tables.

[The deadline for submitting a bid on the web is Sunday, September 23, 2018 to 24.00 hours and can not be exceeded. Written offers must be submitted so that they could be delivered by that date.](#)

Winning items are sent in R letters, postage and packing are added to the prices (according to the size of the shipment). No additional fees are charged! Successful bidders will pay by postal order or by bank transfer to the account 182566063/0800 (Variable symbol "2018xxx", where xxx is the number of the bidder we will assign to you).

When you make a payment in EUR or USD, amount will be recalculated according to the current rate.

The owner of the items will receive from the organizer of auction the total amount reduced by 10%, which serves as a compensation of the other costs of the mail auction.
